



1. No changes or cancellations will be allowed after the application has been submitted.
No refunds will be made for non-participation due to illness or other personal reasons.
2. The organizer will decide on a case-by-case basis whether to reduce or cancel the event due to earthquakes, windstorms, floods, snowfall, incidents, accidents, epidemics, etc. The organizer will decide whether or not to refund the participation fee after deducting the costs incurred up to the time of cancellation.
3. Please note that the organizers reserve the right to make changes to the event guidelines due to the spread of the coronavirus infection.
4. Participants must be free of heart disease or illness. Participants must be in good health and have trained sufficiently to participate in the event.
5. If the organizer determines during the event that there is a problem with the continuation of the event, participants must immediately follow the organizer's instructions. Participants must also follow the organizer's instructions on safety management and event operation.
6. In the event of injury or illness during the event, participants are deemed to have agreed to receive first aid.
7. In the event of accidents, loss, injury or illness, compensation will be made within the scope of the insurance policy taken out by the organizer, except in the case of intentional or gross negligence on the part of the organizer.
8. If a participant is under 18 years of age, they may apply only if their family, relative, or guardian has consented to their participation in this event.
9. False declaration of age, gender, etc., or entry by a person other than the applicant (substitute runner) will not be permitted. If found to be so, the organizer may cancel the entry or awards, or disqualify the applicant from the next or subsequent races. The organizer will not be held responsible for any first aid, refunds, etc. for false declarations or substitute runners.
10. The organizer reserves the right to publish personal information such as name, age, gender, record, and portrait in newspapers, television, magazines, the Internet, pamphlets, etc., in the event video, photographs, articles, and records.
11. The organizer shall comply with the laws and regulations for the protection of personal information.
12. Please follow the instructions of the organizer regarding any other matters related to the tournament.
